On a large sheet of wrapping paper, we draw outlines of the shapes. The children place the shapes onto these outlines.

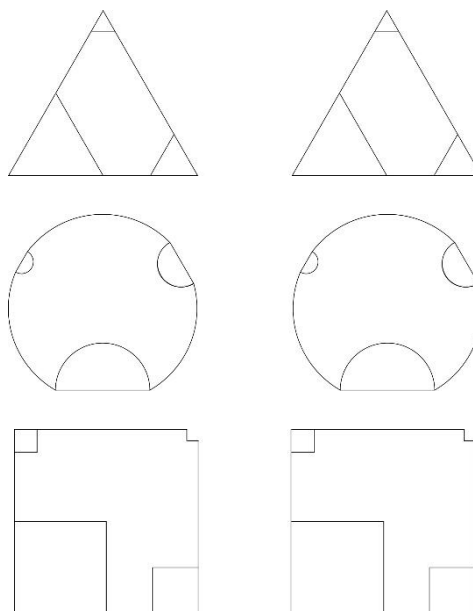
Variations:

At first, only the three shapes separately, then each one is drawn multiple times.

For older children, it can be differentiated in various ways. For example, using the outlines of the 3 basic shapes to create figures, such as making a little house out of a square and a triangle.

We can define the basic colors.

We can also specify the colors of smaller shapes within the drawn shapes on the paper (1, 2, or even 3 colors!).
