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Formal and/or non-formal educational setting: **Both**

Most relevant age group: **3-8 years old**

Description of the idea / problem / exercise: **Find the one without a pair!**

In the picture, all elements except one have an identical pair. The child should find which element does not appear twice in the shape by observing and comparing the elements.



- *Why this exercise is good:* It develops observational skills, attention to small details, and memory. In addition, children enjoy themselves during the game and learn actively.
- *Has anyone tried this? If yes, when and where?:*
- *Notes:* The game can continue by hiding the pair of a different element, and in the same way, the child should find the element that appears only once. We then ask them to create a similar challenge themselves.
