Description of the idea / problem / exercise: **Tale Forest 2**

Once the game pieces are set up, we can play in 3D. We create a forest from the triangle and circle pieces by forming a maze. We can build it together with the children. Task: try to lead the forest animals to the edge of the forest. Be careful, because there are paths that the animals cannot cross. You also have to be careful not to knock over the "trees."



- *Why this exercise is good:* During play, players develop their spatial awareness, spatial orientation skills, problem-solving thinking, dexterity, and patience. (same as in Fairy Tale Forest 1).
- *Has anyone tried this? If yes, when and where?:* We further developed the Meseerdő 1 game, taking into account the children's ideas during free play.
- *Notes:* Can be played with children of mixed ages. Can be linked to several theme weeks (see Fairy Tale Forest 1).
